Question papers were set by subject experts from various medical colleges outside Punjab. The evaluation of the answer books was done on the same pattern. Practical examinations were conducted by external examiners from outside state as well, which were selected from the panel of examiners already approved by The Board of Studies.</p> <p>PG - The PG examination shall be conducted in May/June 2020 as the first batch under this university joined in 2017 only.</p>

Whether external experts are invited for evaluation?	<p>Evaluation of answer books of UG Examination was done under the supervision of Controller of Examinations. The answer scripts were coded by Secrecy Branch allotting fictitious roll numbers. Coded answer sheets were sent to subject experts outside the state for evaluation, under full confidentiality.</p> <p>External experts were not invited for evaluation of answer scripts.</p>
5.9	Mention the number of malpractice cases reported during the last 3 years and how they are dealt with.	<p>The First and the only exam conducted till date was for session 2017-2018. No case of malpractice was reported during it.</p>

5.10	Does the University have a continuous internal evaluations system?	<p>Yes.</p> <p>The marks allocated for internal assessment, as per regulatory bodies, are awarded to students by following systematic procedure of holding internal tests, assignments, quizzes etc. to have complete transparency.</p>																					
5.12	How is the question papers set to ensure the achievement of the course objectives?	<p>Question papers were set by three subject experts from outside state, from the panel duly approved by the Vice Chancellor on the recommendation of the Board of Studies. Paper setters were required to set both A and B question papers, out of which one set of question paper was selected randomly. Each paper setter received detailed instructions regarding the number of hours allotted to each topic of the subject in the curriculum along with the model question paper to enable him/ her to set the question paper covering the entire syllabus of the subject. Inclusion of short questions in each paper further facilitates wider coverage of syllabus in the question paper. Total secrecy was maintained in the entire process.</p>

The Controller of examinations selects/ appoints the paper setters out of the approved panel. The names for invigilation staff are recommended by the Principals of the constituent colleges and approved by the Controller of Examinations.</p>
